# AED Automated External Defibrillator Course

## Course Brief

This course has been designed to highlight the safe and correct use of (AED) Automated External Defibrillator, the course is developed with up-to-date changes in first aid training and the requirements of The Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981. The course is facilitated and enhanced with information and practical assessment.

## Course Aims

The course aims are to train an (AED) operator the vital skills required in a cardiac arrest situation. The (AED) operator will develop the skills and confidence to know how to respond competently in an emergency situation.

Statistical Information - Every two minutes someone suffers a cardiac arrest in the UK, of these one will die every fifteen minutes.

At the end of the session the learner will be able to:

- 1) Describe the main causes and treatment of unconsciousness
- 2) State the basic function of the heart
- 3) Recognise the signs and symptoms of a heart attack
- 4) Demonstrate the safe use and operation of (AED) Automated External Defibrillator

- 6) Cardio-pulmonary-resuscitation for (Adult, Child and infant)
- 7) Explain the action to be taken in an emergency
